#### HOOSIER HEALTHWISE INDIANA'S CHILDREN'S HEALTH INSURANCE

PROGRAM (S-CHIP) Hoosier Healthwise is a healthcare program for children up to age 19 and for pregnant women. The program covers medical care such as doctor visits, prescription medicine, mental health care, dental care, hospitalizations, and surgeries at little or no cost.
